Year 4 to bring **cakes**

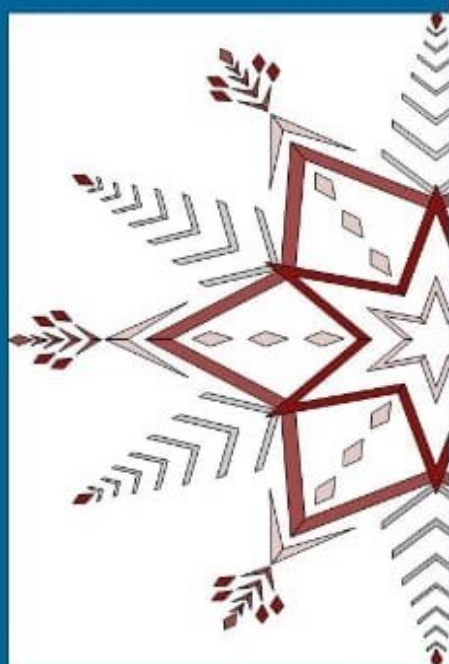
