Corona Virus

I am aware that some of you are concerned about the recent outbreak of Corona Virus. At the time of writing this Newsletter the advice is that all schools are to remain open. The main advice that we are being given is to wash hands regularly with soap and hot water for 20 seconds. All children **MUST** have their own water bottle in school as we are not letting children drink from the classroom cups during the school day. We will aim to keep you updated.
