Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been SATs week in school this week for our Year 6 pupils. I would just like to say that I have been extremely proud of them all over the week. It has been a difficult couple of years for us all, but it is really worth noting that the last full year that our Year 6 pupils had in school was when they were in Year 3. They have approached the week with maturity and have tackled the tests really well. We asked them at the start of the week to just try their best, and they all have! Our Year 2 pupils will start their SATs on Monday. The tests for Year 2 are not as formal as for Year 6 but I am aware that they can still cause children to feel anxious. The children will be completing the tests in small groups over the next two weeks. I wish year 2 luck with their tests. When we come back after half term, Year 1 children will be taking their phonics tests. These are done on a 1:1 basis over the week and the children are asked to read a range of real and nonsense words. The staff have been preparing the children for their phonics test throughout the year. The final year group to sit national testing will be Year 4. They will be taking part in a times table test which they will do individually or in small groups over the weeks beginning 13th June and 20th June. Like Year 1, the staff have been preparing the children for this test over the year.
