

Year 5 news






















Year 5 have had a busy time in school recently as they have been taking part in a social enterprise project linked with Adsa. This has culminated with the pupils in Year 5 running a shop on a Monday evening after school. The shop is 'pay what you can' as Year 5 are aware that we are all living through a cost of living crisis. The shop will continue to run every Monday and we are hoping to take in more stock from Asda soon. Year 5 pupils have also taken part in Peer Mediation training. For this, the pupils had to apply for a position to become a Peer Mediator and then be interviewed. The successful pupils then had 3 days training. Over the coming weeks the staff team will receive some training and I know that the Year 5 pupils are really excited about beginning their new roles.
