Dinner Money – Changes

Prepaying and ordering of school meals will now be done through your School Gateway account. Meals must be paid for before being taken.

A minimum payment of £2.40 must be made for Friday choice and £12.00 for weekly choice.

Meals have to be ordered before 12 midnight, a minimum of 36 hours before the meal is taken. For example: School meals for the first day of term need to be ordered by 12 midnight on Saturday 3rd November 2018

The office is no longer taking cash payments for meals.

Classroom View

We are going to be running our Open Mornings again this year as they proved to be successful and useful for you last year. They will run on Tuesday 20th November and Wednesday 21st November. They will run with the same format where you, as parents, can come in and spend an hour in class with your child. This will give you the opportunity to observe either an English or Maths lesson taking place and watch your child taking part in the learning.
