Children should only be bringing a packed lunch, if they are not having a school meal, a water bottle, their PE kit and their reading book. They should not be bringing in any personal items. We are hopefully going to start our homework via Teams next week, which will be online. I will send details about this out to you once we have them.

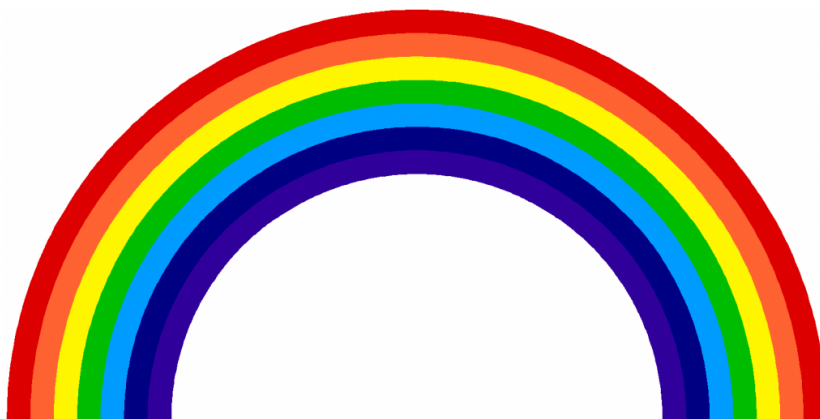
